

All About Eastern Bluebirds



In this class, we will learn about the annual life cycle of the Eastern Bluebird and how to attract them during the breeding season, including proper placement of appropriate nest boxes, what constitutes a good habitat for the birds and their nests, and recommendations for predator control. Mr. Fare will also discuss tips on becoming a good bluebird trail monitor.
