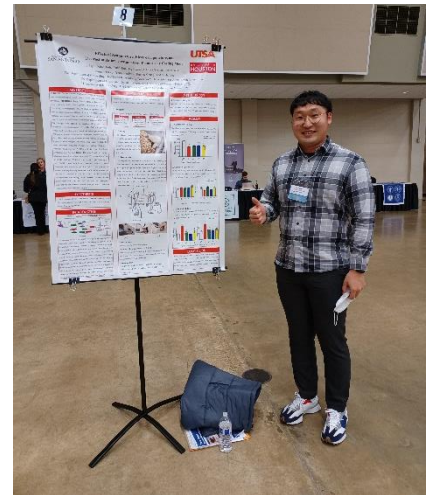
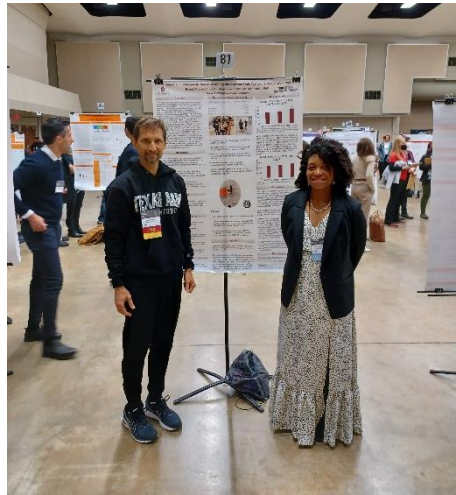


Activities in Kinesiology
