



Urgently Needed: Donations of Men's Shoes and Pants to Assist Patients Being Discharged



Another way to help the patients! Donate gently used clothing, especially men's pants and shoes, for patients who are ready to be discharged from the hospital, but have no clothing available. Currently over 80 patients a month require clothing upon discharge. The majority of them are men.



CARES manages a program through their Thrift Shop and over 80% of the men's clothing donated goes to patients who need them upon discharge.



Yes, you may donate other gently used clothing and your other no longer needed treasures, but the need is greatest for men's clothing, especially large sizes.



Drop off sites are the CARES Thrift Shop (Barracks G on the East side of General Hospital off Zonal Ave.) and IPT Childcare. Drive up service may be arranged for large donations and with advance notice.
