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The Evolutionary Quantitative Genetics Workshop 2025 was held at Mountain Lake Biological Station from June 8th through June 14th. The workshop covered a range of topics from evolutionary quantitative genetics to phylogenetic comparative methods of trait evolution and was led by **Josef Uyeda** and former VT postdoc **Fabio Machado** (now faculty member at Oklahoma State U.) and five co-instructors: **Pat Carter** (Washington State U.), **Jacqueline Sztepanacz** (U. of Toronto), **Laura Alencar** (Yale), **Joe Felsenstein** (U. of Washington, Virtual), and **Joel McGlothlin** (VT BioSci).



Twenty participants joined the week-long workshop from 16 institutions across 5 different countries, including VT BioSci graduate students **Eliza Tarimo** and **Benedicta Ottairoegbu**. Previous versions of the workshop were held annually from 2011-2019 and virtually in 2021 and 2022. This is the first version of the workshop under VT leadership and the first at MLBS.
