As Parent and/or Guardian of the named camper, I hereby authorize the diagnosis and treatment by a qualified and licensed medical professional, of the minor child, in the event of a medical emergency, which in the opinion of the attending medical professional, requires immediate attention to prevent further endangerment of the minor's life, physical disfigurement, physical impairment, or other undue pain, suffering or discomfort, if delayed.

Permission is hereby granted to the attending physician to provide my child routine health care; to administer medications; to proceed with any medical or minor surgical treatment; to order X-rays, routine tests, treatment, immunizations; to release any records necessary for insurance purposes; and to provide or arrange necessary related transportation for me/or my child. In the event of an emergency arising out of serious illness, the need for major surgery, or significant accidental injury, I understand that every attempt will be made by the attending physician to contact me in the most expeditious way possible. This authorization is granted only after a reasonable effort has been made to reach me. Permission is also granted to the CAMP CEO and its affiliates including Directors, Coaches, and Team Parents to provide the needed emergency treatment prior to my child's admission to the medical facility
