Food Pantry FAQs

What documentation should I bring?

You may need ID for all household members, photo ID for all adults, proof of address, and total household income to be made eligible at some pantry locations.

How does it work?

Frequency of visits depends upon the location. You may get items based on weights or points depending on pantry location and your household size.

What do I get?

It depends upon what is available at the pantries. It may include fresh fruits and vegetables, canned and frozen goods, breads, cereals, meats, eggs, and dairy. Some pantries may also offer personal care items and toiletries, diapers, household items, clothing, pet food, and other items.

Nutrition Programs

FoodShare (Food Stamp) Program

Purchase food at grocery stores with a “Wisconsin Quest” debit card. Monthly benefit amounts based on household size, income, assets and other factors. Call or go online at access.wisconsin.gov to apply. (608-242-7441)

Senior Nutrition Program

Serves congregate and/or home-delivered meals for adults age 60+. Suggested contribution: \$5/meal, but please only pay what you can. (608-261-5678)

School Food Service – Madison

Free and reduced priced breakfast and lunch. Contact your child’s school for an application and information. (608-204-4001)

Summer Food Program – Madison

Free breakfast and lunch at various locations throughout Dane County for children under 18. (608-204-4007)

Women, Infants, & Children Program (WIC)

Benefits to buy food and nutrition information to help keep mothers and children healthy and strong. Many working families qualify. (608-267-1111)
