We welcome all to present their best work from recent meetings or preview new work. **The submission deadline is midnight on February 20, 2023.** The posters are requested to be put up for the full day for viewing by the meeting attendees. Presenters are required to have the poster on display by 8:00 am. Poster presenters are asked to be available from 8:00 to 8:50 am to present, and voluntarily are welcome to peer present during any other breaks of the day. Physician peer presenters will be receiving peer feedback cards. Resident-Fellow and Medical Student poster presenters will be juried by a panel and are required to be available from 8:00 to 8:50 am to present to the poster judges.

Each presenter will receive a Certificate of Recognition. For the Resident-Fellow posters, a scholarship prize award of \$200, \$125, and \$75 will be awarded to the first, second, and third place poster presenters, respectively, and a scholarship prize of \$50 and \$25 awarded to the first and second place Medical Student poster, with a certificate of recognition for third place.

For the psychiatric physician peer juried posters, the Society will sponsor gift cards of \$100, \$50, and \$25 to the first, second, and third place posters awarded by peer voting.
