**Physician Invitation.** The Arizona Psychiatric Society invites all Arizona psychiatric physicians to submit an abstract for consideration for a peer juried poster presentation at the Arizona Psychiatric Society Annual Meeting, to be held in a virtual setting on Thursday, May 20, 2021. We welcome all to present their best work from recent meetings or preview new work. **The submission deadline is midnight on April 25, 2021.** Accepted abstract authors will be invited to pre-record a multi-slide presentation of their poster content, which presentation shall be limited to 9 minutes for presentation, and if chosen for the live virtual Poster Session, you will be asked to be available live for a 2-minute opportunity for Q&A from the judges or peers, as the case may be, on Thursday, May 20, 2021. If there are more posters accepted than the time allotted for May 20, 2021, your accepted and pre-recorded video presentation will be posted for viewing to all Annual Meeting attendees. Peers will be invited to provide feedback to the physician peer presenters and vote upon the same. Resident-Fellow and Medical Student poster presenters will be juried by a panel and are required to be available to present pursuant to scheduling coordinated through the Arizona Psychiatric Society.

Each presenter will receive a Certificate of Recognition. For the Resident-Fellow posters, a scholarship prize award of \$200, \$125, and \$75 will be awarded to the first, second, and third place poster presenters, respectively, and a scholarship prize of \$50 and \$25 awarded to the first and second place Medical Student poster, with a certificate of recognition for third place.

For the psychiatric physician peer juried posters, the Society will sponsor gift cards of \$50 and \$25 to the first and second place posters awarded by peer voting.
