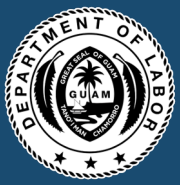

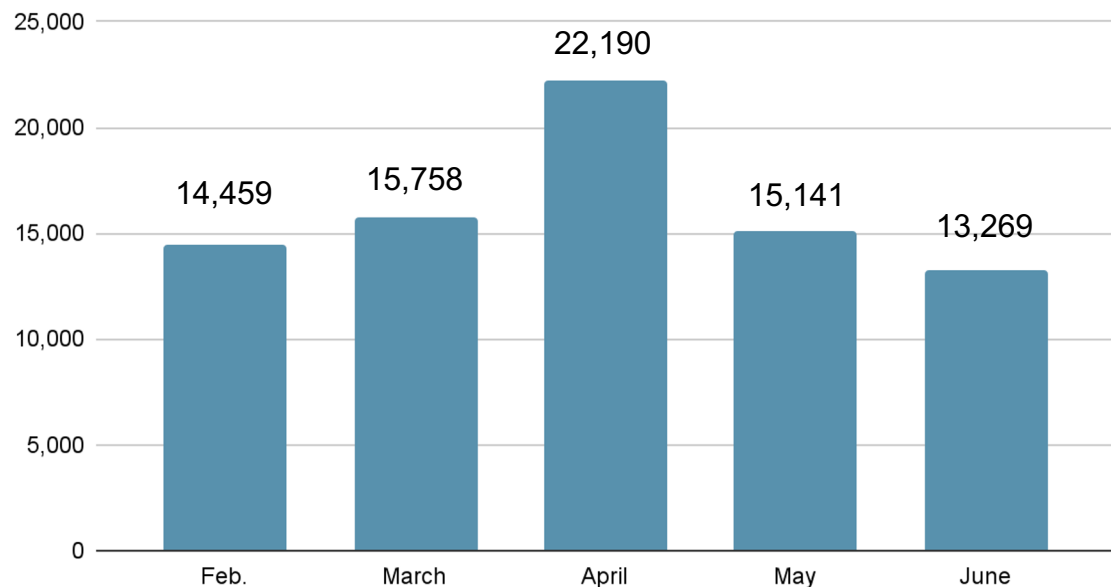


Pandemic Unemployment Assistance

PUA Job Search Requirement

- **USDOL turns on job search requirement.**
- **Guam to implement before end of July 2021.**
- **Three (3) job searches a week required.**
- **Project 10K unemployed.**

Exemptions

- Employees working reduced hours.
- Individuals in an approved job training program.

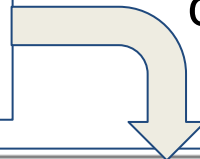

Bisnes Para i Taotao

“Business For the People.”

- Initial program goal to employ 5K-6K workers.
- New program will subsidize \$9.25 in wages up to 480 hours.
- Total is about \$4,800 per new hire.
- Most details will depend upon total funding.
- Single application in partnership with GEDA.
- GEDA’s Small Business Pandemic Assistance Grant: Helps small businesses recover from the effects of COVID. Max grant of \$50K.
- Application process will start in July.
- Aiming to disburse funds starting in Oct.
- GDOL program is inclusive, open to small and big businesses.
- Employers, submit your job openings.
