RE: *Public comments on rules and guidelines, Guam Cannabis Industry Act*


Dear Chairwoman Williams and Members of the Guam Cannabis Control Board,

Thank you for the opportunity provide comments regarding the rules and guidelines associated with the Guam Cannabis Industry Act. The Guam Chamber of Commerce respectfully submits the following recommendations:

- Clarify the term “public consumption” and “public place” to exclude: any places in Tumon and “H” zoned areas (to include restaurants, bars, homes, dwellings and hotel rooms rented to guests);
- Clarify that the no smoking policy extend to all hotels and motel rooms;
- Advertising and sale of cannabis and related products be prohibited in Tumon; and,
- Include the development and establishment of a district away from Tumon that will support the development of the industry, separate from our “family friendly” tourism industry.

We would additionally appreciate being included in further official notices regarding the industry moving forward. Thank you for your consideration and we look forward to your favorable response to our recommendations.
