WHO CAN REGISTER TO VOTE?



Must not be confined to a mental institution;



Must not be judicially declared incompetent;



Must not be committed under a sentence of imprisonment;



Must be a citizen of the United States;



Must be 18 years of age by the day set for an election (every person that meets all eligibility requirements to register and is sixteen (16) years of age or older, may preregister to vote);



Must be a resident of Guam.



REGISTER AT THE DMV!

Department of Revenue & Taxation,
Motor Vehicle Division

Qualified individuals may opt to register to vote or update their voter registration record when they apply for a driver's license or Guam ID.
