

Sunset: Finish davening Mincha before sunset

- Sunday – 6:10pm; Monday – 6:09; Tuesday – 6:07pm; Wednesday – 6:06pm; Thursday – 6:05pm

Ma'ariv: Daven Ma'ariv after sunset
