Our Church History Tour is designed to make sure that we learn a lot about our church's history while having plenty of fun along the way! We will visit many sites of the early days of the church, but we won't just focus on the dates, locations, and events that occurred at each historical site. We are going to focus on how the lessons learned at each site can help us grow closer to the Savior in our everyday life.

## July 10 – July 15, 2023

Below is a detailed itinerary of our upcoming Church History Tour

**July 10:** Today you will fly to Syracuse, New York. Before each travel segment, optional reading assignments will be provided. These readings will come from the Book of Mormon, General Conference talks, and articles relating to the history we will witness. Each participant will be responsible for their own lunch and dinner today. Our hotel shares its property with a few restaurants.

**July 11:** Our bus will pick us up early this morning and we will spend the day seeing the sites of Palmyra. Our stops will include the Sacred Grove, the Smith Family Farm, the rebuilt log home where the Moroni visits took place, the Hill Cumorah, the Grandin Press (where the Book of Mormon was first published), the Martin Harris Farm, the Palmyra Cemetery, and the exterior of the Palmyra Temple. Each participant will be responsible for their own dinner tonight. A 6:00pm Temple Session at the Palmyra Temple might be available for those interested. Reservations are required. Please let us know if you are interested. (Breakfast and Lunch provided)

**July 12:** We begin our day in Harmony, PA and at the Susquehanna River. It was here that the Priesthood was restored and where most of the Book of Mormon was translated. The homes of Joseph and Emma, and the Isaac Hale home have been rebuilt. New monuments and statues have been installed, and a new Visitors' Center is now open. Our day will conclude in Fayette, NY at the Peter Whitmer Farm. This is where the Church was officially organized. It was also in Fayette that the Three Witnesses saw the angel and the plates. Some of the Book of Mormon was also translated at the Whitmer Farm. (Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner provided)

**July 13:** We will spend some time today at Niagara Falls where we will ride the Maid of the Mist for an up-close view of the majestic Falls. Later, we will make our way to Kirtland. (Breakfast and Dinner provided)

**July 14:** We will start the day with a tour of the interior of the Kirtland Temple. It was here that the Savior appeared to Joseph and Oliver. Moses, Elias, and Elijah also appeared and restored Keys of the Priesthood. We will visit the Visitors' Center, the Newell K. Whitney home (where Joseph and Emma lived) and the Newell K. Whitney store (which included the School of the Prophets and where many revelations, including the Word of Wisdom, were received). We will also visit the John Johnson Inn (where the Church periodical *The Evening and Morning Star* was published), the reconstructed Kirtland Schoolhouse, and the Kirtland Ashery along with a reconstructed water-powered sawmill. We will visit the Morley Farm where General Conference was held, the Father and the Son appeared, where missionaries were first sent from, and where the first High Priests of this dispensation were ordained. We will also see the exterior of homes belonging to Joseph Smith, Hyrum Smith, and Sidney Rigdon. Our day

will conclude at the John Johnson Farm in Hiram, Ohio. It was here at the John Johnson Farm that Section 76 was received. Joseph and Sidney saw the Celestial Kingdom, the Father and the Savior, and many other things in the upper room of this home. This is a very sacred place. We will have a catered lunch at the Chaplin Forest Stone Quarry where much of the stone for the Kirtland Temple was obtained. Dinner will be at a famous Amish restaurant. (Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner provided)

**July 15:** The hotel has a free shuttle to take you to the Cleveland Airport for your flight home.
