



Brevard County Commissioners to Host Town Hall Meeting in Palm Bay

Palm Bay, FL - Brevard County Commissioners Kristine Isnardi (District 5) and John Tobia (District 3) announced on March 3rd that they will be hosting a general town hall on April 4, 2017, 6:00 p.m., at Palm Bay City Hall.

All Brevard residents are encouraged to attend this public event and let their voices be heard on the critical issues facing our county. This town hall will offer a unique opportunity for citizens to ask questions of their South Brevard County Commissioners and receive brief legislative updates on topics such as infrastructure, surplus county land, use of Indian River Lagoon tax proceeds, and community redevelopment agencies.

"This event gives us a chance to meet our residents and let them know that we are here to help with any issues they may have," Commissioner Isnardi said. "I always enjoy the opportunity to hear from my constituents and learn what I can do as their Commissioner to improve the quality of life in their communities."
