



LOCAL COORDINATING BOARD SEEKING VOLUNTEER MEMBERS

BREVARD COUNTY, FL. -- The Brevard County Local Coordinating Board for the Transportation Disadvantaged Services is seeking applications for volunteer members for its board.

The Local Coordinating Board (LCB) was established by Chapter 427 of the Florida Statutes to provide direction and advice to Space Coast Area Transit in the provision of the Transportation Disadvantaged Services in Brevard County. The LCB consists of 17 members from various state and local agencies and general interest groups.

The LCB is seeking volunteer members and alternates for the following seats: Disabled Representative; Disabled Representative (Alternate); Persons over Sixty Representing Elderly of the County (Alternate); Citizen Advocate - System User (Alternate). The term of appointment is 3 years and the LCB meets quarterly at the Viera Government Center.

Once all the applications are received, a subcommittee will review the applications and make a recommendation to the Space Coast Transportation Planning Organization for approval. The deadline for receipt of applications is July 24, 2017.
