Standard rates apply to adult and family camps throughout registration season.

DEPOSITS + PAYMENTS

We accept the following payment forms: Cash, Check, Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express. Credit card payments will incur a 3% fee.

We offer ACH payments for no additional fee.

Registration Office must receive payment in full by May 15th. Registrations after May 15th must be paid in full at the time of registration.

We require a \$175 deposit per program for each person. These deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable. Your registration is not considered complete until NovusWay receives your paid deposit.

MULTI-CHILD DISCOUNT

Families with more than one child attending camp this summer are eligible for a sibling discount. After you register the first child at regular price all subsequent children will receive a \$35 discount. This discount only applies to children who live in the same household; it does not apply to any family camps or custom groups. This discount is applied automatically when you register. If you have any questions contact the registration office.

TIERED PRICING

Realizing that families have different abilities to pay, the camps of NovusWay Ministries – Lutheridge, Lutherock, and Luther Springs - utilize a voluntary Tiered Pricing System for summer camp. You may choose the tier that is the most suitable and affordable for your family. It is important for parents to understand that every camper receives the same experience no matter what tier is chosen. It is also important to note that we have scholarship funds available to provide assistance for families who are unable to afford Tier 1 pricing. It is our goal that every child be able to attend camp, regardless of their ability to pay.

ABOUT TIERED PRICING

TIER I – PARTIALLY SUBSIDIZED. This is our historically subsidized rate and does not reflect the true cost of operating summer camp programs. This is the rate you have always paid. This reduced rate is made possible through the mission funding dollars we receive from individual donors and churches who value the impact that the summer camp experience at Lutheridge, Lutherock, and/or Luther Springs has on children, youth, individuals, and families. This rate makes the camp experience available to more families.

TIER II – DIRECT COST. This rate represents the direct costs of camp. Direct costs include program costs, food, summer staff, and camp administration costs.

TIER III – TRUE COST. This rate more closely accounts for the true costs of camp. True costs include all direct costs plus deferred maintenance, insurance, utilities, etc. Choosing Tier III gives you an opportunity to help us do more with the donor funding we receive. You help us stretch our limited scholarship funds further so more children can experience the power of camp. You help Lutheridge, Lutherock, and Luther Springs make needed upgrades and continue to grow in the future.

Our Goals with Tiered Pricing:

- To provide high quality, safe, fun, and inclusive activities for all God's children in the midst of God's creation.
- To build a diverse Christ-centered community where every person is valued.
- To provide an opportunity for partnership with those who value the impact of camp ministry.
- To preserve Lutheridge, Lutherock, and Luther Springs for generations to come.

We are grateful to our donors for investing in our campers and making it possible for us to offer a subsidized rate as well as scholarships. Again, this program is voluntary and confidential and in no way influences the experience children receive, yet it offers the opportunity for families to take an active role in supporting the true cost of their child's camp experience.

SCHOLARSHIPS

At NovusWay, we believe that camp should be accessible for all youth regardless of financial ability to pay. As a faith-based non-profit, our donors give to support this mission, making scholarships available. PAYMENT PLANS

Payment Plans are available upon request; we offer automated drafts from a credit or debit card or bank account on the 1st and/or the 15th of each month, for whatever amount best fits your situation. Call 828-209-6302 to discuss your options.

CANCELLATION POLICY

All cancellation requests must be made in writing. Email to registration@novusway.org or mail to: NovusWay Ministries, PO Box 830, Arden, NC 28704. Cancellations made 30 days or more from the program date are eligible for a full refund minus the non-refundable deposit of \$175. Cancellations made less than 30 days notice but more than 10 days are eligible for a refund of 50% of the program cost minus the non-refundable deposit of \$175. Cancellations made within 10 days or fewer do not qualify for a refund. In the event of illness or extenuating circumstances, NovusWay registration may make additional allowances.

FLEXIBILITY NOTICE

Outside vendors/partners for our outdoor adventure activities sometimes change. If any of our listed vendors/partners are unable to offer our listed activities, we will work to find comparable activities for campers.

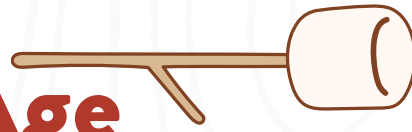

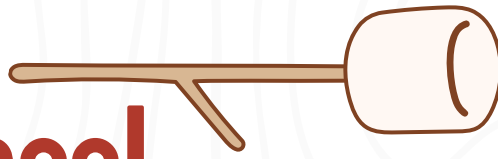

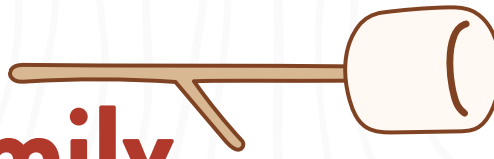
