3. Are you involved in some form of ministry by which you give your time and talents in or through your church?
4. Are you working to maintain your personal devotional life through regular prayer and study and through periodic gatherings with a small group of other Christians for fellowship, study and prayer?
5. Are you and your family committed to trusting God with a tithe (10%) of your anticipated income?
6. Are you prepared to seek opportunities to explain your faith describing in appropriate ways God's action in Jesus Christ and his work in your life?
7. Do you accept the responsibility of demonstrating your faith through your living, maintaining a good reputation and manifesting the fruit of the Spirit in such ways that Christ is glorified?
8. Are you willing to serve as an "elder" of your congregation, seeking only God's will for his Church, and giving attention to the spiritual life of the congregation as well as to the financial and administrative decisions?
9. Are you willing to support parish functions — social and spiritual — with your work and attendance, placing parish activities high on your list of priorities?
10. Are you committed, as God enables you, to attend every meeting of the vestry, to participate in the annual retreat, and to pray daily for your parish?
