2022 Program Goals

In 2022, the Summer Youth Internship Program aims to employ approximately 130 young people in City of Milwaukee positions.

Why is this program so important?

- Provides better opportunities and a bright future for our youth.
- Develops Milwaukee's future workforce that will build our community and local economy.
- Gives youth the opportunity to earn some cash and learn different skills.

Program Details

- 8 week program beginning June 2, 2022, and ending July 29, 2022
- 20 hours per week
- \$15.00 per hour
- Good school attendance helps determine ranking
- High school juniors and seniors have priority

What can you do to help?

- Spread the word about this wonderful program.
- Encourage every junior and senior high school student who is between the ages of 16 and 19 to apply.
- Make computers available to youth so they can complete the online application.
- Write letters of recommendations if the youth is called for an interview.
- Facilitate providing the needed transcripts for eligibility.
- Encourage no absences – good attendance - since this is part of the ranking criteria.
