

Virtual Learning at SJA: What to Expect

As you already know, due to the public health circumstances in the state, we will be doing virtual learning at SJA from March 30-April 3. Our completion date is yet to be determined based on state requirements. We will continue to keep you updated on return dates via email. In the meantime, this is what virtual learning that means for you!

- Starting on Monday, March 30th, virtual school will begin and all students are expected to participate in the schedule below. Attendance will be taken via your activity on Google classroom and absences will be counted against your totals just as they are during the school day. Parents will be contacted if you are not logging in to your Google classrooms to complete work.
- Each student should have received an SJA Chromebook with instructions on how to log on. If you don't have technology access to do your work, please contact Ms. Lingen immediately.
- It is critical that you watch your school email and Google classroom notifications carefully so you know what is going on with school in general and your specific classes.
- Teachers will be uploading readings, assignments, videos and some tests/quizzes via the Google classroom. In addition, there will be online class discussions in which students will need to participate with one another. Your completion of all of these tasks will factor into your grades for the second semester
- Teachers will be available via email and Google classroom messaging during all regular school hours of the schedule below. You can contact a teacher during your regular class block and expect an immediate response unless they are actively leading the online discussion or a video stream. Teachers will also be responding to messages during what is normally their prep period and they aren't moderating another class.
- If for some reason you cannot work on class activities during the time indicated below, you must contact your teacher and Mrs. Schroeder via email to explain when you will make up the time.
- You are welcome to contact teachers outside of school hours, but you may not receive an immediate response. You will always receive a response within 24 hours. Email and Google messages will be the best way to reach teachers.
