It took 50 teams of horses and 200 men working together for a year in order to clear the land of boulders and debris to prepare it for what would become one of Canada's premiere golf courses. 

ARK TSISSEREV

Arkady Tsisserev is the Senior Associate with the AES Engineering, electrical consulting company with offices in BC and Alberta. Before joining the world of the electrical consulting business in 2010, Ark was the Electrical Safety Regulator for more than 25 years. Since 1993 and until 2010 he has held the position of the Electrical Safety Manager, Chief Electrical Inspector & City Electrician for the City of Vancouver. Before moving to the City of Vancouver in 1993, he was Head of Electrical Section for the City of Winnipeg Inspections Department since 1984. Ark has written and published many articles, course notes, and taught various CE Code and fire alarm and emergency system courses at the University(s) of B.C., BCIT; University of Manitoba and via other venues. Ark writes by-monthly columns for the "International Association of Electrical Inspectors News" and for "Electrical Line" journals. Ark is an active member of many industry associations and is involved in numerous technical committees with such organizations as CSA, NFPA, IEEE, ULC, SCC, SFPE and IEC. Mr. Tsisserev was for many years chairing the BC Electrical Code Adoption Committee. Ark is the Immediate Past Chair of the CSA Technical Committee for the development of the CE Code and of the CSA Strategic Steering Committee for the Requirements of Electrical Safety. He also actively participates in the ULC Technical Committee for the development of ULC S500 series standards. Ark represents the CSA on the NEC Technical Committee, and he chairs the Canadian National Committee on the IEC TC 64. Ark started his work in the electrical industry in 1962 as a construction electrician. Ark is a certified electrical inspector in the Province of BC and a member of various provincial engineering associations in Canada. He has obtained his undergraduate and PhD Degrees in Electrical Engineering from the State University in Ukraine in 1972 and Master's Degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of Manitoba in 1984.

Correlation between the Canadian Electrical Code and the National Building Code regarding application and installation of the electrically connected life safety systems.

This presentation covers provisions of the CE code, Building Code, relevant CSA, NFPA and ULC standards for application and installation electrically connected life and fire safety equipment such as fire alarm systems, emergency generators, fire pumps, sprinkler systems including heat tracing equipment, transfer switches, smoke alarms, exit signs, emergency lighting, electromagnetic locks, hold open devices, elevators and protection of conductors supplying this equipment against exposure to fire. **Why this subject is presented:** To assist members of the ECAA in a consistent application of the CE code requirements and the CE code references to the NBC and to the relevant installation standards on this subject.

Specific aspects of learning outcome: Understanding impact of building classification on application and installation of electrically connected life safety systems. Building code requirements for hold open devices and electromagnetic locks: what, why and how; Criteria for installation of fire alarm system in a building; Electrical supervision of fire alarm system; Signals to fire department; Sprinkler system and heat tracing cables – electrical supervision and fire alarm zoning requirements; Audible and visual signal devices; Smoke and heat detectors; Smoke alarms; Life safety systems in high buildings; Smoke control and smoke venting equipment; Emergency lighting and exit signs; Fire pumps – the NBCC, NFPA 20 and the CE Code requirements; Emergency generators; Automatic transfer switches; Protection of electrical conductors against exposure to fire; Automatic elevator emergency recall; Commissioning on integrated life safety systems. ULC S524 – installation criteria for fire alarm system components; The CE Code and electrically connected life safety systems. Checklist for electrical designers.

Low-voltage Installations and the Canadian Electrical Code

There are now dozens of POE systems being installed regularly throughout offices and facilities on every project. Currently many of these devices operate up to 100W per port. These systems (except for lighting) do not require an electrical permit.

As these systems approach the limits of Class 2 cabling we see changes to the CEC, (see section 16-330). The way we install Category cabling requires attention, also noted in the 2018 Code Book. What does it all mean to our industry?

In this open-mike forum low voltage contractor Jason Burke and Electrical SCO Larry Cantelo will attempt to clarify the permitting requirements as well as have an open discussion about these installations.
