How it will work:

On February 20, a small number of volunteers will be located at the covered Saint Clement School parking lot on Orchard. To ensure social distancing, we ask that you place all food donations in bags or boxes in your vehicle's trunk. Upon arrival, please enter the covered lot from Orchard, pull forward, stop as directed, and pop your trunk. Remain in your vehicle while a volunteer removes the food from your trunk, and then exit the garage through the alley garage door. Boxes will also be available on the curb for those who would like to pass by on foot and drop off a donation.

Donations will also be collected all weekend (2/20-2/21) during parish office hours. Feel free to drop off a donation in the marked bin at reception before or after Mass!
