# NAZARENE YOUTH CONFERENCE 2026

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **How to register:**

1. Bring \$500 deposit to NYI convention on July 26, 2025
2. When deposit is paid, students will be handed a registration card with a QR code that contains an individual registration link on it.
3. Students must hand this card to their guardian to register. **Students cannot register themselves - there are consent forms that need to be signed.**

- If a student registers after October 15, 2025, headquarters requires an extra \$75 fee. If a student registers in October or later, \$1,075 will be due at their time of registration.

- **Making Payments:**

- For all payments after the initial deposit, churches are required to send 1 church check each payment cycle
- Example: if a church has 3 students attending, youth pastors should collect \$500 from each student, then send in 1 check for \$1500 from their church.

- **Mandatory In-Person NYC meeting:**

- All students and sponsors attending NYC 2026 must attend an attendee meeting in May 2026
