## DESIGNATE A CONTACT PERSON



Assign a reliable person to assist the missionary prior to and throughout their visit to ensure all needs are met. The contact should be accessible by email and phone.

## COMMUNICATE WITH THE MISSIONARY

# 2

As soon as your missionary is scheduled, the designated contact person should communicate important details to them including logistics, special needs, and reimbursements associated with the visit.

Missionaries will want to know:

- Date, start time, and time zone of the event
- GPS friendly address
- Name and phone number of a contact person
- Type of event (missions service, Faith Promise, children, youth, small group, etc.)
- How many times they will speak and length
- Anticipated audience age and size
- Dress code for the event
- Church/district involvement with their ministry or country
- Availability of technology, including projection capabilities

## PROMOTE THE EVENT

This is an opportunity for your congregation to hear what God is doing around the world. Use the missionary's online profile from the [Nazarene.org](http://Nazarene.org) website for information, materials, and photos. Some missionaries may not be listed for security reasons. Always verify with your missionary before using their name or photo online or in printed materials. Also confirm if your church posts services online.



## ASSIST WITH TRAVEL COSTS

Missionaries cover travel expenses personally or through deputation funds. Churches and districts are encouraged to help with meals, mileage, airfare, and lodging reimbursement.

## ENSURE COMFORTABLE ACCOMMODATIONS



Provide accommodations that meet the missionary's needs, including internet access. They may prefer a hotel, Airbnb, or staying with a church family - ask their preference. Verify the number of people traveling. Also, ask about dietary restrictions and let them know of any meal plans ahead of time.



## 6

### CREATE SPACE FOR DEEPER CONNECTION

Missionaries value connecting with your church. Schedule time for your congregation to get to know them. Encourage interaction with small groups, youth, and children, and stay in touch after the visit.

### SUPPORT OTHER IN THE MISSION OF GOD

Discuss with your missionary how to support one another in God's mission. Ask them to share about the World Evangelism Fund and ways your church can get involved. Collect offerings after the missionary speaks, and clarify beforehand how funds will be distributed (i.e. Funding the mission, check

## 8

### CONTRIBUTE FINANCIAL SUPPORT

In order to provide space for the congregation to respond, receive the offering after the missionary shares at the end of the service or gathering. Deputation funds help with specific missionary needs such as ministry expenses, housing, travel, medical deductibles and co-pays, children's education, and more.

How to send funds in the US:

**1. Churches -**

Use the Funding the Mission website. Log in, click the "Giftbox" icon, select "GTS Contribution," and choose "Missionary Deputation." Search for the missionary's name.

**2. Individuals -**

Give through the missionary's online profile for one-time or recurring gifts.

**3. By mail -**
