Newberry, SC – Celebrating its 15th annual event, the City of Newberry's Oktoberfest will be held in historic Downtown Newberry on Saturday, October 1st lasting from 10:00 AM to 6:00PM. This festival of German heritage has something for everyone and admission is free.

Visit an array of fine arts and crafts vendors, spread throughout the festival area. Authentic German food, quality barbecue, gourmet, and American fare will be available in the food court as well as a variety of domestic and German beverages in the acclaimed biergarten. Live music will be featured on the Rocktoberfest stage all day including polka and German traditional tunes, rock and roll, and variety hits. At 12:30pm the stage will host the Best German Costume contest for anyone attending the festival in traditional Bavarian attire. Families will want to stop by Kindertown for FREE kid's inflatable bounce houses, carousel, and video game truck, and free balloon animals as well as vendors specializing in face painting, children's toys, books, and more.

Festivalgoers will also have the opportunity to tour the Newberry Opera House, see FREE puppet shows at the Ritz Theater, and view the Newberry Car Buff's classic car display, now by the setting of the newly renovated Coca Cola Mural in downtown.
