Theme: "Conference of Renewal: Why We Do What We Do as Mercy Educators"

On Wednesday, October 13, the conference opening will include prayer and a keynote presentation by Sr. Áine O'Connor, a member of the Institute Leadership team, entitled "Living Mercy, Living Hope" emphasizing the Mercy Charism and Critical Concerns.
