Planet or Plastics - November 16th

Sea birds are dying because their bellies are full of plastic trash. Microplastic particles are in the air we breathe, the water we drink and some of the food we eat. Plastic recycling has been an epic failure and plastic production contributes to climate change and major pollution in low-income communities and communities of color. Learn about these issues and what you can do to help us move beyond plastic through personal choice and advocacy.

Presenter: Judith Enck, Environmental Policy Expert, and founder of Beyond Plastics, an effort to end plastic pollution through education, advocacy, and institutional change. She teaches classes on plastic pollution as a Senior Fellow and visiting faculty member at Bennington College.
