Required documentation for adults:

- 1. Photo ID- for you and any person living in the household 18 years and older
- 2. Latest utility bill, phone bill or rent receipt showing name and proof of current physical address for all adults (no PO boxes)

Required documentation for all children:

You must provide documentation for EACH child living with you by bringing one of the following that verifies: name, address and date of birth:

1 A document from school or daycare center indicating each child's name, address and date of birth OR a document from a DSHS office or other social service agency verifying each child's name, address and date of birth

OR a WIC folder (with current WIC checks showing child name) is acceptable for participants in this program
