Joe Niamtu, III, DMD is a Board Certified Oral and a Maxillofacial Surgeon and Board Certified Cosmetic Facial Surgeon with a practice limited to cosmetic facial surgery. He has over two decades of experience administering and teaching neurotoxin usage for cosmetic and functional treatment of the head and neck. He has written numerous articles and textbook chapters on the subject and has lectured on the subject on six continents. He was one of the early adapters of cosmetic neurotoxins in Virginia and remains in the top 5% of users nationally for the largest neurotoxin company.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

PART 1 — The 8-Hour Didactic Training/Lecture is required BEFORE participating in the Live Hands-On Injection Training. Part 1 Training includes eight hours of study as outlined by the Virginia Board of Dentistry. This course includes videos, handouts, lectures and support materials for the safe and effective use of neurotoxins.

**After you have registered, you will receive a link for the course material from April at Dr. Niamtu's office. Please reach out ASAP if you do not receive the link or if you have trouble opening it.*

PART 2 — The Live Hands-On Course is Part 2 of the certification course for a dentist to become certified to inject neurotoxins as outlined by the Virginia Board of Dentistry. Part 2 of this course is 4 hours of Live Hands-On Injection Training.

The Dentist must have a dental license and malpractice coverage (does not have to be neurotoxin coverage, but a license).

Each attendee must inject at least two patients. **It is up to the attendee to provide the patients to inject (they may also inject each other).** The dentist patient relationship is between the course attendee and their patient and not the Richmond Dental Society or Dr. Niamtu. Attendees will be required to submit before and after pictures within 2-4 weeks following the treatment. Any complications must be reported to Dr. Niamtu.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

Attendees will learn the following:

- Assessing patients for use of botulinum toxin injections
- Screening of patient expectations and psychological motivations
- Diagnosis, planning and treatment
- Informed consent, including off-label use of botulinum toxins
- Anatomy and neurophysiology of the head and neck
- Indications and contraindications for the use of botulinum toxin injections, including off-label and approved product uses
