What Children Are Eligible for Assistance Under the Compact? Children of:

- Active duty members of the uniformed services, National Guard and Reserve on <u>active duty</u> orders
- Members or veterans who are medically discharged or retired for 1 vear
- Members who die on <u>active duty</u> The student shall maintain military family status for <u>1</u> year after the date of death.

What Children Are <u>Not Eligible</u> for Assistance Under the Compact? Children of:

- **Inactive** members of the National Guard and Reserves
- Members now retired not covered above
- Veterans not covered above
- Dept of Defense personnel, federal agency civilians and contract employees not defined as active duty
