

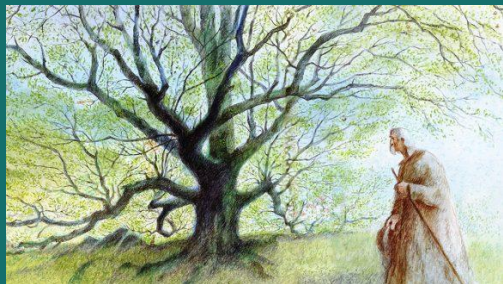
Trees Water and Peace
