Upon our move the VHM administrative office is currently located at 830 W. Mulberry Ave. Our transitional housing program continues at the La Posada Apartments where we currently have four families in residence. FAREWELL BLESSING

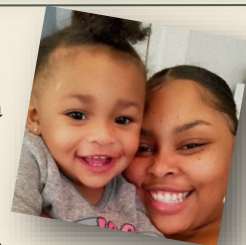

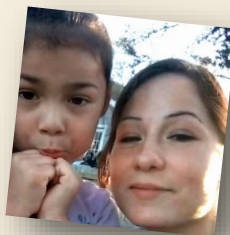
SUPPORTIVE HOUSING PROGRAM

With your help and support of our mission we celebrate the five families who call La Posada apartments home. We are proud of the moms who participate in the VHM supportive housing program. They are committed to achieving their education goals and to nurturing and caring for their children.

Khadījah has completed her first semester at San Antonio College (SAC), pursuing an associate degree in Human Services with a specialization in Addiction Counseling, A.A.S. Her daughter XIA (16 months) is thriving at Avance and has graduated to the toddler room due to her walking, emotional and intellectual development.



Jennifer has also completed her first semester at SAC where she is pursuing an associate degree in Nursing. Her daughter Leiahnnah (4yo) is registered for Kindergarten in the fall having completed her pre-K year and as her schedule allowed participated in our afterschool enrichment program activities.



Christina has enrolled at SAC and is excited to begin her general education courses of study this summer. While awaiting the start of her classes she has worked fulltime as a home care provider, one that brings her great joy and satisfaction. Her son Liam (3yo) loves daycare but is also looking forward to the fall when he can start pre-kindergarten and join our afterschool enrichment program with the big kids.

Felipa continues to pursue her GED taking classes at Restore Education. Jason has flourished during his first year of school, experiencing structure and learning in a group setting. His sisters, Jazmin and Kamilah attend daycare.

Stephanie and her three children recently received approval for housing through the San Antonio Housing Authority (SAHA) and exits the program to avail of this wonderful opportunity. We appreciate the partnership with SAHA to support our efforts to secure permanent housing for exiting families. Since joining VHM Stephanie has pursued her associate degree in social work at SAC and a work study program at William R. Sinkin Eco Centro, a community outreach center for environmental sustainability operated by SAC. Her children have blossomed in the program and gained a solid education start. They are on track to progress to their next grade levels for the 22-23 academic year; Ron to 4th, Delilah, 3rd and Zofia to 2nd. This year, Delilah joined her school's dance team and had several performances, and Zofia has moved up three guided reading levels. Ron maintained AB Honor Roll and also increased his reading proficiency.

AFTER SCHOOL ENRICHMENT PROGRAM



The afterschool enrichment program fostered social emotional learning in **Spring Break Enrichment Camp 2022**. Case manager, Tami and her afterschool enrichment team organized the camp based on the theme "*Bloom Where You Are Planted*". Sporting camp T-shirts, the children and staff participated in lessons and activities to increase self-awareness, self-control, and develop interpersonal skills. Emphasis was placed on helping others bloom and staying away from things and people that would stop you from blooming. Fun was had by all!

COMMUNITY PARTNERS SPOTLIGHT



South Alamo Regional Alliance for the Homeless (SARAH) is the lead Continuum of Care (CoC) agency for San Antonio and Bexar County. The CoC Program is designed to promote communitywide commitment to the goal of ending homelessness. SARAH is responsible for collaborating with, listening to, and collecting data from the housing and homeless community to ensure everyone has a place to call home. Visitation House Ministries is an active member of the CoC and appreciates the support that SARAH provides. We have recently applied to become a Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) user. HMIS is a local information technology system used to collect client-level data and data on the provision of housing and services to homeless individuals and families and persons at risk of homelessness. We are excited to expand our knowledge base, increase our proficiency in coordinating service provision, and managing our operations to better serve the women and children who call VHM La Posada apartments home.
