Thank you for your prayers and continuing support. We are truly grateful for your commitment to transform lives, one woman, and one child at a time.

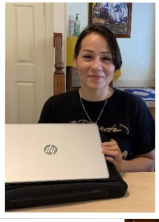

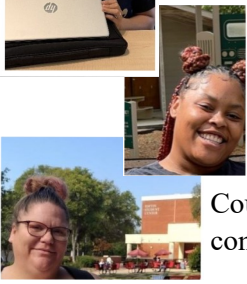

The moms in our program are first-gen students i.e. first in their families to pursue college degree programs, with little or no experience navigating the academic, financial, and cultural barriers to higher education, including application processes which sometimes bamboozle even the most savvy. VHM Case Manager, Tami Farquharson, LMSW worked in conjunction with the San Antonio College (SAC) collective and the comprehensive educational supportive SAC Empowerment Center to overcome these hurdles. Jennifer, Khadijah, and Christina are registered full time students at SAC for this fall semester. Jennifer has already successfully completed two semesters and a full course load of summer classes and is working towards an Associate in Applied Science Degree in Nursing. Khadijah also successfully completed two semesters and a full course load of summer classes and is working towards a degree in Human Services, with a specialization in Addiction Counseling, A.A.S. Christina has successfully completed spring and summer courses and is working towards completing intermediate courses with the goal of choosing a degree plan this spring.



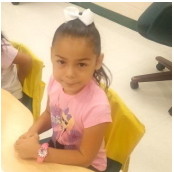

In addition to providing educational accompaniment to women in the program and the broader community through its GED Program, Outreach has expanded to integrate remote case management.

Remote Case Management provides:

- Support and orientation to help participants access a wide range of services for which they and their families may be eligible (medical, behavioral, health, employment, social and education).

- Product Support, providing personal care items that help meet the individual or family or household needs.

Outreach also includes Phone-Based Support for callers in need of human services, providing referrals and connections to resources available among peer social agencies, nonprofit organizations, congregations, government agencies, and compassionate groups in and around San Antonio.

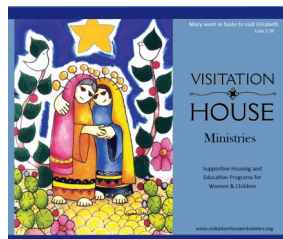
SAMA campaign runs until January 2023
