For the past 29 years, St. John's Parish Day School families and staff have joined with St. John's Episcopal Church and its Outreach Ministry to prepare holiday baskets for families in need. This year, with your help, we hope to provide gifts and toys for the 90 children in 36 families identified through the Club at Collington Square, an after school enrichment program in Baltimore. The children range in age 3 weeks old to 17 years of age.

If you wish to participate, we encourage you to allow your child to help choose the gift. We ask that you spend whatever is comfortable for your family. For easier sorting, **please do not wrap your gift or put your child's name on the present.** If possible, please provide gift receipts in case exchanges are necessary.

Your child will be invited to present his or her gift(s) in Chapel beginning November 28, when the gift collection will be explained to them. The last day to bring a gift is Friday, December 15th.
