School Tuition and Attendance Policies:

Temple Israel Religious School Tuition Grades K-7 (pre Bar/Bat Mitzvah)

Religious school registration is open to all members in good standing of Temple Israel

- Registration Fee due with registration form: \$100 each child grade K-7.
- Members: \$440 per child

Bar/Bat Mitzvah Tutoring Fee: Applies to all students currently in or entering group or private Bar/Bat Mitzvah lessons with Rabbi.

- Tree of Life Leaf to commemorate your child’s simcha \$126 (7th grade x Chai). (Optional)

Tuition and Fees for High School Class (Grade 8 through 12, post Bar/Bat Mitzvah)

Registration fee is for all High School Students – Teachers’ Aide (Madrachim) and Class.

Madrachim must have completed both 7th grade and had their first Aliyah as Bar or Bat Mitzvah.

- Registration Fee due with registration form: \$100 per child

Classroom attendance: Meeting once per week, (except for Bar and Bat Mitzvah prep) every class is an important one and each missed class means children miss important information. Beginning with the 2019-2020 Temple Israel has the following classroom attendance policy. Students are expected to be in class, doing homework as assigned at with at least an 85% percent attendance and completion rate. (2019-2020 = 5 days) Students who do not meet minimum attendance or homework requirements risk moving to the next grade, or scheduling of their Bar or Bat Mitzvah ceremony or a recommendation that a previously scheduled Bar or Bat Mitzvah ceremony be changed.

Shabbat Morning Services Attendance Requirement: Preparation for Bar/Bat Mitzvah at Temple Israel and Shabbat morning service leadership and participation are two of the goals of the educational program for grades K-7. Meeting just once per week means families must support additional learning through homework and services attendance. Regular Shabbat attendance (Friday evening and Saturday morning) overcomes many of the limitations experienced in the classroom.

Children are always welcome at services, regardless of their age. Beginning in fourth grade students should be at Shabbat services at Temple Israel regularly. The attendance requirement is:

- 4th Grade: six times per year – Friday evening will count toward this total
- 5th Grade: 12 times per year – Six Friday evenings will count toward this total
- 6th & 7th Grade: 18 times per year – Six Friday evenings will count toward this total
- In the last six months prior to Bar/Bat Mitzvah, at least 3 of every 4 weeks – Shabbat (Saturday morning) only.

There will be an attendance taking system in place. Junior Congregation will count toward the attendance requirement. Please note: if your child fails to meet the attendance requirement for Shabbat morning services particularly in grades 6 and 7, the synagogue, the Rabbi, Lead Teacher, and other members of the board or religious committees at their sole or joint discretion, may recommend rescheduling of the Bar or Bat Mitzvah ceremony.

We want your child to shine and for the family to enjoy the simcha. PLEASE attend services as required – service attendance for is an obligation, as is coming to class every week.
