The purpose of this program is to help your child get ready for kindergarten. The curriculum for this program will focus on:

- 1. Learning readiness skills.
- 2. Social interaction skill development related to building new adult and peer friendships.
- 3. Learning social skills of how to share and take turns.
- 4. Acquisition of listening skills and following directions.
- 5. The development of language skills through a variety of language experiences.
- 6. Hands-on exploration of various types of art media.
- 7. The development of physical and coordination skills through games of low organization.
- 8. Music activities related to group singing and rhythms.

BUS STUDENTS: A name tag will be provided for all Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten children riding rural and shuttle buses. These tags will include their name, school destination, address, home phone number, and bus route number or shuttle site. The tags MUST be worn for all 20 days of Summer School.
