
Simchat Limud: A Celebration of Learning and Confirmation

Here is what your child can look forward to every Sunday morning this year:

T'filah with Cantor Hyman – A prayer service designed to teach the words and meaning of foundational Jewish prayers.

Panim el Panim (Face to Face) with teachers Sharon Forman and Sam Donsky – A chance for students to develop friendships, ease into the school day, and learn about the weekly Torah portion and upcoming holidays.

Hebrew Through Movement with teacher Adina Brody – Interactive, experiential Hebrew lessons that get students moving, and increase comfort and familiarity with hearing Hebrew.

T'filah and God with teachers Sam Donsky and Sharon Forman – Delving into the meaning of our prayers and Jewish ideas about God, and into students' own feelings on these big ideas.

Jewish Life Cycle with teachers Sharon Forman and Sam Donsky – Learning about the unique and wonderful ways that Jews mark pivotal moments in our lives.

Plus...

- A weekend retreat for 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders at Camp Harlam the highlight of the year!!
- Holiday celebrations for Sukkot, Simchat Torah, Hanukkah, Purim, Pesach, Yom Ha'atzmaut, and Lag B'Omer!
- Family Shabbat dinners once a month.
- Youth group events led by Youth Engagement Coordinator, Jem Oshins.
- Sh'mot Shabbat twice a year students and families gather together for a Shabbat morning service followed by lunch.

*The five books of the Torah are B'reishit (Genesis), Sh'mot (Exodus), Vayikra (Leviticus), Bamidbar (Numbers), and D'varim (Deuteronomy). Torah is fundamental to Jewish life and learning, so our school is built around Torah! Students within a Community of Torah share t'filah (prayer/worship) and other aspects of life at Berkman Mercaz Limud and enjoy youth group events together, and their teachers collaborate on shared goals appropriate to the developmental stages of the children in their community.
