# Part of the Sh'mot* Community of Torah at Berkman Mercaz Limud 

## Here is what your child can look forward to every Sunday morning this year:

T'filah with Cantor Hyman- A prayer service designed to teach the words and meaning of foundational Jewish prayers.

Panim el Panim (Face to Face) with teachers Todd Hacker and Dalia Weinstein - A chance for students to develop friendships, ease into the school day, and talk about the weekly Torah portion.

Jewish History and Tradition with teachers Todd Hacker and Dalia Weinstein - Learning how to distinguish between documented history and the traditions of Tanakh (the Jewish bible) and exploring the story of Jewish people from our origins through the Middle Ages.
Plus...

- A weekend retreat for 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders at Camp Harlam.
- Fabulous holiday celebrations for Sukkot, Simchat Torah, Hanukkah, Purim, Pesach, Yom Ha'atzmaut, and Lag B'Omer.
- Family Shabbat dinners once a month.
- Youth group events led by Youth Engagement Coordinator, Jem Oshins.
- Sh'mot Shabbat twice a year -students and families gather together for a Shabbat morning service followed by lunch.
- Hebrew reading! Either in chevruta (small groups) on Zoom during the week with Adina Brodie, Midweek Hebrew online on Tuesdays, or in-person Midweek Hebrew on Wednesdays. If your child is not already registered for one of the Midweek Hebrew sessions, Jennifer will contact you early in the fall to plan for chevruta learning.
*The five books of the Torah are B'reishit (Genesis), Sh'mot (Exodus), Vayikra (Leviticus), Bamidbar (Numbers), and D'varim (Deuteronomy). Torab is fundamental to Jewish life and learning, so our school is built around Torab! Students within a Community of Torah share t'filah (prayer/worship) and other aspects of life at Berkman Mercaz Limud and enjoy youth group events together, and their teachers collaborate on shared goals appropriate to the developmental stages of the children in their community.
