## Madeira Beach Seeks Community Opinions with Annual Survey

MADEIRA BEACH, FL – The City of Madeira Beach wants to know what its residents, business owners and visitors think about the direction the city has taken over the last year. The Board of Commissioners, in collaboration with city staff, has issued the 2019 City of Madeira Beach Community Values Survey.



The survey, which is available on the city’s website, poses thirty-two questions in the areas of economic development, affordable housing, government transparency, project priorities and more. Last year, the first time the city issued the survey, more than 530 people provided their opinions on the direction of the city.

“The Community Values Survey is an important tool used by the Board of Commissioners and city staff in prioritizing where to devote taxpayer resources in our community,” said City Manager Jonathan Evans. “While it is not scientific, the survey is important because it provides a snapshot into the issues the community feels are most important to not only maintaining but improving the quality of life in Madeira Beach.”
