TRANSFORMING EDUCATION

Computer Science Education & Equity

Helps students build skills in computational and critical thinking, collaboration, and creativity. Increases computer science awareness, enthusiasm, and proficiency for students, particularly for girls, underrepresented minorities, English language learners, and students with special needs.

National Board Certification

Supports teachers pursuing the “gold standard” for teaching, which transforms classrooms. BSF has inspired more than 400 teachers to achieve their National Board Certification. This support has helped Bellevue have the highest number of certified teachers in the state.

Arts, Enrichment, & Innovation Grants AND Inspiration & Incubation Grants

Enhances students’ education with innovative learning opportunities in and out of the classroom, such as music, field trips, visiting authors and artists, STEM, innovative tools, books, and more.

Community Engagement

Deepens community and parents’ understanding of current education topics, from lunchtime presentations on research and best practices to round table discussions on topics like mental health, child well-being, and more.

SUPPORTING STUDENTS

Mental Health

Training for staff members in schools to identify and help students struggling with mental illness. Provides instruction to students about how to recognize behaviors associated with suicide risk in oneself and others.

Early Learning

Provides the most vulnerable students in our community access to high-quality early learning, where they enjoy learning and constructive play with peers and develop the social and cognitive skills to be ready for kindergarten.

Culturally Responsive Classroom Libraries

Increases reading proficiency by providing culturally responsive books that engage all students in the joy of reading. The books serve as a mirror to those whose lives are reflected in them and as a window to those reading about new cultures. This year we are refurbishing elementary libraries and expanding to secondary libraries.

Equity BOOM Experience

Expands this successful program that engages Black, Native American, Latino/a, Southeast Asian and Pacific Islander secondary students with mentors who identify with them racially and culturally.

College in High School Tuition Assistance

Assists students who qualify to cover the costs of earning college credit for certain courses offered in high school.

Strong Start Summer Math

A program to assist students with learning recovery in math.
