



## 2020 Sea Pines Trolley Information

Safety remains Sea Pines CSA's top priority as Trolley service to the Blue, Green and Red Routes resume during the COVID-19 pandemic. Enhanced safety protocols and modified hours of operation have been implemented in light of COVID-19, which can be found below.

### **Modified 2020 Service Hours and Route Locations**

The trolley service to the Blue, Green and Red Routes will operate June 22 – September 7, 2020 with the following modified services times.

<b>ROUTES</b>	<b>June 22 – September 7</b>
<b>BLUE</b>	<b>9am – 5pm</b>
<b>GREEN</b>	<b>9am – 5pm</b>
<b>RED</b>	<b>4pm – 10pm</b>

#### **BLUE ROUTE**

Runs from the Harbour Town Trolley Stop to Sea Pines Beach Club and makes stops at Harbour Town Swimming Pool, Racquet Club Villas, Heritage Pad at Lighthouse and Plantation, The Shops at Sea Pines Center, Plantation Club Villas and Plantation Golf Club.

#### **GREEN ROUTE**

Runs from the Harbour Town Trolley Stop to South Beach and stops at The Shops at Sea Pines Center.

#### **RED ROUTE**

Runs from the Greenwood Drive Trolley Stop to Harbour Town and makes stops at Lawton Stables and The Shops at Sea Pines Center.

### **For your safety: Enhanced safety protocols**

- **Request to riders:** Please be advised, close contact amongst passengers is expected. Passengers ride at their own risk. If you feel sick, have a fever, cough or other symptoms, please stay home and do not ride the trolley. Wash your hands frequently and avoid touching your face. Riders should practice social distancing when waiting for the trolley and when queuing and boarding the trolley. **Please be patient as increased wait times are expected for this service on all routes.**
- **Personal Protection Equipment is required:** All passengers and trolley drivers will be required to wear cloth masks or face coverings when aboard the trolley. Refusal to wear a mask or face covering or acting in an unsafe manner will result in denial of entry or expulsion from this service.
- **General Trolley Information:** Trolleys will operate at 50% capacity. Staff will continuously monitor capacity levels on all trolleys to determine if additional reduction in seating capacity is needed. The trolleys will be cleaned with disinfectant sprays and all hard surfaces and high-touch areas will be cleaned at the end of service on a daily basis. The driver reserves the right to deny service.

## Trolley Rules or Disclaimers

1. No pets allowed (service animals only).
2. No unattended children (under the age of 10).
3. No alcoholic beverages in open containers.
4. No coolers or beach accessories from the Greenwood Trolley Lot.
5. Proper attire is required at all times.
6. Keep all extremities inside trolley while moving.
7. All abandoned articles will be stored at the lost and found located at the CSA Administration building 175 Greenwood Drive.
8. Do not throw objects from the moving vehicle.
9. Driver has the right to refuse service.
10. No weapons allowed on trolley.
11. No fishing gear except collapsible poles.
12. Eating is prohibited on the trolley.
13. No standing on the trolley while in operation.
