This course is intended to pique your interest and familiarize you with topics in palliative care. We have many excellent speakers who will present on a range of topics, including racial discrimination in the treatment of pain and access to palliative care, spiritual care in serious illness, serious illness communication, pain and non-pain symptom management, advance care planning, moral distress, burn out and ways to "fill your cup," build resiliency and practice self-care in your work. Best of all, you will hear from a panel of your nursing colleagues who are experts in palliative care!

Note: The class focuses mainly on the adult population, but content is applicable across all nursing practice settings, and all are welcome.
