

What You Need To Know and Do

To Be A Part of the Junior High Production of Shrek The Musical Jr.

- Prior to auditioning, you must be sure that you have no conflicts with the rehearsal schedule which will begin the week of October 1st through November, Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday after school until 5:00 pm. During the weeks that there is a holiday or school is closed, an additional day will be added to the week. If you play a sport, or have another after school activity that will conflict weekly with this schedule, please do not audition. If you are unsure if an activity is a “true” conflict, just see me and we can discuss in further detail. (*Vacations, Dr's appointments, extra help and after school clubs that end at 3pm do not count as a conflict.*)
- **Auditions** for **8th** graders will take place immediately after school in the cafeteria until 5:30 pm on **MONDAY 9/27**. **Auditions** for **7th** graders will take place on **TUESDAY 9/28**. **Callbacks** will take place on **Wednesday 9/29**.
- Students Auditioning for a role within the show **must read and complete** the Audition packet attached and bring with you to your audition.
- Students who would like to participate in **Scenic Design or Stage Crew** must read and complete the Crew Application packet and return to me after school in the cafeteria on **OCTOBER 4th**. You will receive an email with further instructions and details regarding your crew role and rehearsal dates.
- **Parents of both Cast and Crew:** A mandatory parent meeting will be held in the cafeteria on Monday October 4th at 7pm. It is very important that a parent or guardian be in attendance at this meeting. ***There have been several changes to how our JH production will be conducted this year and it is important that we have a parent in attendance.*** Also a full rehearsal calendar and packet will be given at this time.
