

EDWIN E. EHEMANN

JACKSON CENTER — Edwin Eugene Ehemann, 77, of Jackson Center, passed away Friday morning, Feb. 3, 2017, at Heartland of Indian Lake.

Ed was born in Shelby County on June 29, 1939, to the late Kirby F. and Alice L. (Fogt) Ehemann.

Ed was a graduate of Jackson Center High School and obtained his Bachelor of Science degree in Secondary Education from Ohio Northern University. He was a former teacher and had coached baseball, basketball, track and football. Ed was a basketball official and worked 1,265 games. Ed managed the family farm, Ehemann Brothers Farm, LLC, which he co-owned with his brother Kirby Ehemann Jr.

Ed enjoyed pitching horseshoes and had run some 10K races. He was a member of the Shelby County Retired Teachers, the Ohio Retired Teachers, the Shelby County Horseshoe Pitchers, **40-year member of this Ohio Horseshoe Pitchers Association and the National Horseshoe Pitching Association.** Ed had previously worked at Copeland Corp. in Sidney and several temporary employment agencies in recent years.

Ed is survived by his brother Kirby L. Ehemann Jr. of Fremont, Ohio; a nephew Kyle T. (Sayuri) Ehemann, of Louisiana; nieces Trenda Ehemann, of Fremont and Trilby (Jim) Leach, of Tennessee.

Graveside services will be held Monday, March 27, 2017, at 11 a.m. in Glen Cemetery.
