DPBC Pre-Primary Delegates...

Are elected by ward and Congressional District to vote for **placement** of **statewide and federal candidates** on the 2022 primary election ballot

Are encouraged to attend the **February 26 DPBC Pre-Primary Convention**

Are encouraged to attend the **2022 DPNM Pre-Primary Election Nominating Convention** which will be held on Saturday, March 05, 2022 at the Roswell Convention Center

Must Vote by absentee ballot **beginning at 6:00 PM on March 5, 2022**

Automatic Delegates

There are two types:

State Certified Automatic Delegates: SCC Members	County Certified Automatic Delegates: Ward Chairs
<ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ SCC members are “state certified” automatic delegates✓ SCC members DO NOT count against a ward’s delegate allocation.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ Ward chairs are “county certified” automatic delegates✓ Ward Chairs DO count against a ward’s delegate allocation<ul style="list-style-type: none">✓ If Ward Chair is an SCC member they are "state certified" and they do NOT count against the ward's allocation.
See the Table of Delegate Numbers for a visual explanation of the allocation.	

Automatic delegates should not run for election. Votes erroneously cast for them will NOT be counted.

DPBC Pre-Primary Delegates

1. DPNM has decided to have a convention of 800 elected delegates **plus** SCC members.
 - According to DPNM Rules, **SCC members are Automatic State Certified Delegates.**
2. The 800 elected delegate positions are divided among New Mexico's 33 counties.
 - Of those 800, **306 have been allocated to Bernalillo County.** Allocation is calculated by the counties' Democratic Performance Index (DPI).
3. Our county rules call for us to have a “pass-through” convention
 - which means that **every delegate and alternate elected** during the 2022 DPBC Delegate Elections **will be a delegate or alternate to both the county and state pre-primary conventions.**

DELEGATE Q&A

Question 1: How is a person nominated as a delegate?

Answer: *Self-nomination will be an option on the voter registration form.*

Question 2: Should the Ward Chair or SCC members living within the ward be nominated?

Answer: *No. They are automatic delegates. Ward Chairs are county certified automatic delegates and SCC members are state certified automatic delegates.*

Question 3: Can delegates have a proxy vote for them in the DPNM State Pre-Primary election?

Answer: *No. The 2022 DPNM State Pre-Primary election will be held by absentee voting. Proxies are not necessary or allowed.*

 - As a candidate for delegate

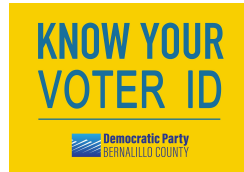
To be eligible to participate as a voter or delegate, a person must be:

1. Registered as a Democrat at least 30 days prior to the first day of elections. This year, this deadline is January 13, 2022.
2. Live in the DPBC Ward where they will be voting (e.g., I cannot live in Ward 30A but vote for delegates in Ward 30B).

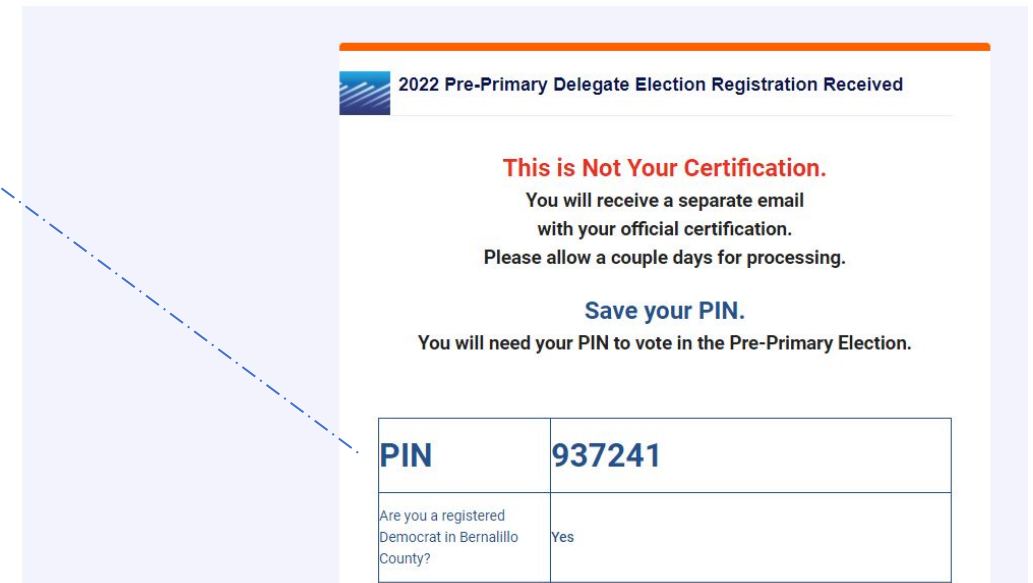

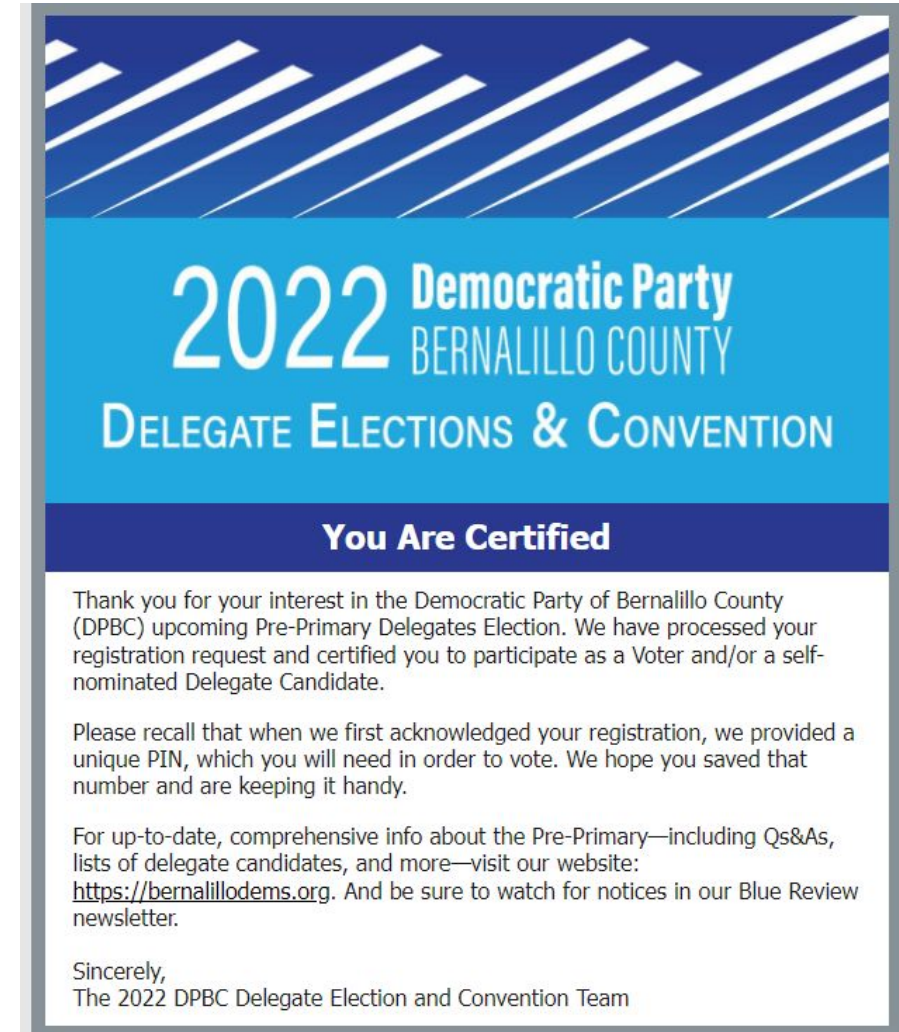

Voter Certification

- Prospective electors and delegates must be vetted to ensure they are eligible to vote or to serve as a delegate.
- After the Registration Team determines the eligibility of the voter, the voter will receive an email confirmation.

February 12: Certified voters will receive an email with a link to their ward's ballot.
