Over this next year, we want to answer your questions about how the school stewards your generous and faithful gifts to the mission of Crean Lutheran High School. This week, we would like to clarify the two areas your gifts support.

Saints Fund - Gifts to the Saints Fund are used to enhance the CLHS Experience with excellent programs and facilities. Your tuition dollars cover 87% of your students experience at CLHS. The remaining 13% is covered through the prayers and generosity of our community. This 13%, not covered by tuition, includes: academic programs, student services, sports programs, tuition assistance, facility maintenance, administration, and more. All gifts from the Saints Fund appeal letters, Treasure the Truth Benefit Dinner, and Saints Golf Classic go toward the Saints Fund.

North Campus Press On Campaign - Gifts to the Press On Campaign are used for the \$6 million North Campus, which opened for our students in the Fall of 2018, and the recently turfed and lighted Saints Stadium. By faith, CLHS used a bridge loan to initiate this important campus expansion so our students would have the space they need for a well-rounded education and to empower our athletic programs. Through generous and sacrificial gifts from many of our current and alumni families, we have raised \$3,895,888. We are continuing to raise resources for the North Campus and will break ground on the final two buildings in the near future.
