Fully Online Protocol

When: In a state of emergency, Crean Lutheran High School (CLHS) campus may not be accessible or school attendance may be discouraged. This may be the result of a natural disaster or a public health emergency. Decisions related to the implementation of the Fully Online Protocol will be made by the school Principal, Dr. Dan Moyer, in partnership with CEO Mr. Jeffrey Beavers and Crean Lutheran's Board of Directors.

Why: CLHS teachers have developed a continuity plan to deliver academic content and rigor for each course if in-person classes are canceled.

How: CLHS teachers will continue to deliver daily planned lessons with the same content as they would on-site via Canvas. Below is a set of actions with resources to help implement a plan that works best for each course to promote the welfare of our students.

On-Site Class	Online Class
Attendance	→ Teachers will continue to track attendance with Aeries.
Discussion	→ Teachers will use Canvas Discussion Forums to post a prompt and require students to respond.
Assignments	→ Students will submit assignments through Canvas.
Direct Instruction	→ Teachers will post presentations, online resources, or videos to Canvas. Video lessons can be made using Screencast-O-Matic and Edpuzzle. Interactive presentations can be made using the Pear Deck “student-paced mode”.
Projects	→ Students completing group projects will use G Suite apps (Gmail, Google Docs, etc.) to continue collaborating.
Assessments	→ Teachers will use Canvas Quizzes to deliver quizzes and tests.
