The Format: Entering our inaugural season of PGA Junior League (PGAJLG), we are very excited to begin growing junior golf in Acushnet. Here's how it works:

- Boys and girls ages 7-13. Golfers of all abilities are welcome, even beginners!
- Coaching by PGA Professional Issac Moniz
- Format of team style golf and not individual stroke play. 9 hole matches with kids playing better ball of partners
- Four team division consisting of other area golf clubs that we compete against
- Participants receive team numbered jerseys, bag tags with "Captured Flag" stickers, and a tee shirt
- End of season team cookout!

The Schedule:

- Weekly team practices (90 mins) will be on Mondays at 5:30pm beginning June 5th
- 6 matches either home or away (typically late Saturday or Sunday afternoons) beginning in June and running through end of July
- Some players may be selected for the All-Star team which begins play in early August

The Fees:

- \$175 per junior
