



No Uniform Days

(taken from page 30 Parent/Student Handbook)

The principal may deem an academic day a NO UNIFORM DAY. A no uniform day always demands appropriate, modest dress.

- No crop, tank or halter-tops (midriff may not be exposed)
- No spaghetti straps or low cut blouses
- No clothing with rips or holes
- No violent or vulgar T-shirts
- No short shorts, or miniskirts (at least fingertip length shorts)
- No form fitting clothing—tops or bottoms—when skinny jeans/pants or leggings are worn,
back side must be covered by a longer shirt.
- Appropriate shoes or sneakers must be worn—no flip flop type shoes, sandals must have a back strap.
- No deviation from other aspects of uniform code (socks, jewelry, makeup, hair, etc.)
- Hats are not allowed to be worn in the building
- Students may not be out of uniform on scheduled Mass days
