
## Team Haiti180 Contest to Win a Nintendo Switch!

## **Team Haiti180 Nintendo Switch Contest Details**

Sean Forrest was a rising musician playing for celebrities like Billy Joel and the president of the Motion Picture Association of America, when he had a radical conversion to the Catholic faith. He left his music career to become a youth minister, but felt God calling him to give more. Sean Forrest went on a mission trip to Haiti in the early 2000's and had a powerful encounter with Jesus Christ in the abandoned children he met there. With no training, he teamed up with a priest from Haiti, bought a field in the mountains, and built an orphanage named Kay Mari Children's Home. As he saw more needs, he built Immaculate Conception Catholic School (that serves 400 kids), 2 elderly homes, and St Mother Teresa Medical Center. Now Haiti180 is a registered 501(c)3 not-for-profit public charity, has a board of directors, and a team of people including a Catholic sister, a brother, and a Catholic priest (Fr Louis). Their mission is to raise up well educated and faith filled leaders for Haiti, and fill the lives of these children with peace and joy.

To fund the orphanage, school, medical center, etc, Sean started something called Team Haiti180. When you sign up for Team Haiti180, you pledge to give a recurring donation of \$15/month. You receive regular updates on what is happening at the orphanage and in their community, and a picture of one of the kids. The recurring donation ensures monthly funding to take care of everyone there.

Because of spiraling fuel costs and inflation, gas prices are over \$40 per gallon in Haiti and trucks are unable to deliver food. Sean said that mass starvation is taking place. He currently feeds 600 people per day, and needs to raise that to 1,000 people per day. I invited him to our area to raise money for Haiti, and to recruit as many members for Team Haiti 180 as possible. Sean is coming to our area to put on a free concert for families at St John Neumann Hall in Freetown on 2/17/23.

I am running a contest leading up to Sean's arrival. Whoever can get someone to sign up for Team Haiti180 for the recurring \$15/month membership, will receive a raffle ticket which will go into a drawing for a Nintendo Switch! If you already own one, the winner could choose to instead receive \$300 in Amazon gift cards.
