

Mask Making Instructions—Pattern at end of instructions

Be sure to sanitize all tools used in the making of these masks and wash the material used beforehand

1. Trace pattern piece on one piece of fabric-right or wrong side-
Fold over fabric, cut two pieces with either right sides or wrong sides together. I lay two folded pieces of fabric together, one on top of the other, so one cut yields all four. We need about 50% regular size and 50% larger size. For a “large” add an extra inch to the edge with the narrow end pieces where the elastic will go.



2. Sew two pieces, right sides together, on the curved edge. Trim seam. Repeat on other two pieces.



3. Press seam to one side on one piece, the opposite side on the other piece.



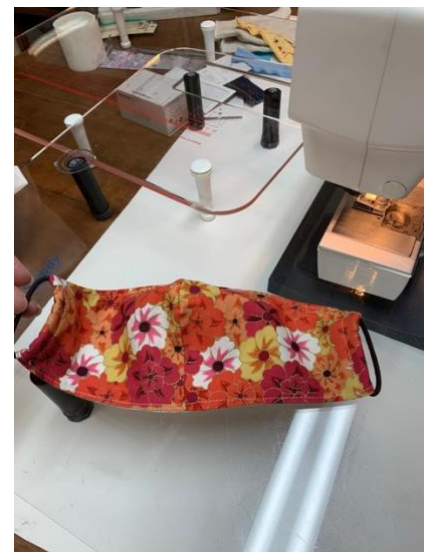
4. Pin pieces together, sew together, leaving 4" open on the bottom.



5. Turn mask right side out, press, top stitch around the mask



6. Lay scrunchy or elastic on fabric end piece. Fold fabric over scrunchy, sew down fold. Repeat on the other side. For a “large”, cut the elastic in half to make the ear holes longer and use a wider stitch. Sew the hair tie into the mask like you would regular elastic.



7. Drop off at the Church! Please bag masks individually (ex. In a sealed sandwich bag), and drop of at Wash Park UMC between 9 am – 5 pm, Monday through Friday. Please label each bag with “regular” or “large” so we can tell them apart when we pass them out. A box can be found inside the double glass doors off the parking lot. Please use the hand sanitizers and wipes present to decontaminate yourself as you enter and leave.
